ABKA Championships

Freedom Dojo in Owasso (9602 N. 177th E. Ave) is hosting again this year on April 28th. This is our biggest tournament each year.

- Doors open at 8:30, judges meeting at 9:15, competition starts at 10:00. The cost is \$50 for ages 13 and up (\$45 if pre-registered), and \$35 for 12 and under (\$30 if pre-registered), with a family maximum of \$120 (\$100 if pre-registered). April 21st is the pre-registration deadline.
- The theme this year is "Do Your Best" from II Timothy 2:15.
- First, second, and third place trophies will be presented to winners of every division. There
 will be place podiums for photo opportunities. Fighting divisions for ages 14 and up will be
 continuous fighting.
- There will be three grand champion awards: one for men's fighting, one for women's fighting and one for forms. The fighting champions will receive title belts and the kata champion will receive a trophy. The names of the champions will be the first ones on each award and they will be passed on each year to the new (or defending) champions each year.
